

Submission of the Paper:

- Deadline for Submission: **December 31, 2025**
- Submission Method: Papers must be uploaded using the [designated form for contributions](#):
- Publication Details: The paper will be published in a peer-reviewed conference proceedings (PDF) available as Open Access..
- Review Result Announcement: Results of the review process will be announced by **May 2026**.
- Publication of Conference Proceedings: The conference proceedings will be published in **September 2026**.

Guidelines for Formatting Contributions:

- Scope: Contributions should be between 5 to 15 standard pages (9,000 to 27,000 characters).
- Font Type: Use Times New Roman throughout the document.
- Font Size: The font size should be 12 points.
- Text Alignment: Align the text to both margins.
- Line Spacing: Use line spacing of 1.15.
- Style: Apply the Normal MEDIG style.
- Margins: Set the margins (left, right, top, and bottom) to 2.5 cm.
- Font Style: Use normal font style.
- Please note that contributions will not be proofread. Therefore, the author is solely responsible for the linguistic, stylistic, and content quality of their submission. A significant number of grammatical or factual errors, or non-compliance with the specified guidelines, may result in rejection of the text for publication.

Specific Instructions:

Title of Contribution: Use Times New Roman, size 12, bold, all uppercase. Add a space of 12 points after the paragraph. The text should be centered – **Style: Title MEDIG**.

Author's Name: Use Times New Roman, size 12, italic. Add a space of 12 points after the paragraph. The text should be centered – **Style: Name MEDIG**.

Abstract: Write the abstract as a single paragraph. Use Times New Roman, size 12, and add a space of 12 points after the paragraph. Align the text according to the margins – **Style: Abstract MEDIG**.

Keywords: Write each keyword as a single paragraph, separating them with commas. Use Times New Roman (TNR), size 12, italic, and add a space of 12 points after each paragraph – **Style: Key Words MEDIG**.

Title of the Introduction, Conclusion, List of References, and Information about the Author: Use Times New Roman (TNR), size 12, all uppercase letters, and bold. Include spaces of 12

points before and after the paragraph. The text should be left-aligned and should not specify chapter numbers – [Style: Introduction MEDIG](#).

Please organize sections into a maximum of three levels: :

- **Section Heading Level 1:** Section number without a period (e.g., 1 Section Heading). Use small caps, bold formatting, and left alignment. Ensure there are spaces of 12 points before and after the paragraph. [Style: Heading 1 MEDIG](#).
- **Section Heading Level 2:** Section number without a period after the last digit (e.g., 1.1 Section Heading). Use bold formatting and left alignment. Ensure there are spaces of 12 points before and after the paragraph. [Style: Heading 2 MEDIG](#).
- **Section Heading Level 3:** Section number without a period after the last digit (e.g., 1.1.1 Section Heading). Use italics and left alignment. Ensure there are spaces of 12 points before and after the paragraph. [Style: Heading 3 MEDIG](#).

Images, Graphs, and Tables Submission Guidelines:

- Please upload images, graphs, and tables separately to the form in PNG, JPG, JPEG, or XLS file formats.
- Insert images, graphs, or tables directly into the text, ensuring that they are centred on the page.
- Label each image, graph, or table as "Image (Graph or Table) No. X: Name of the image, graph, or table," where "X" is the number of the graphic item. Use bold font for the label and italic font for the name, with the font set to Times New Roman, size 12. For example: **Graph 1:** *Name of the graph*.
- Centre all text associated with the graphic.
- If you are not the author of the graph, image, or table, please provide the source in brackets below its title. Format the source as follows: use Times New Roman font, size 10, with one line spacing between the title and the source.
- Place both the label and title of the image, graph, or table, as well as the source, below the respective graphic element.

Citations & References:

- Citation Style: APA 7;
- Citation Methods:
 - Direct Citations: For direct quotes, cite as follows: Hocheľová (2000, p. 15) states... or place the citation after the quote (Hocheľová, 2000, p. 15):.
 - Indirect Citations: When paraphrasing, use the following format: Hocheľová (2000) states... or cite at the end (Hocheľová, 2000).
 - Two Authors: For works by two authors, format as follows: Osvaldová & Halada (2019) identify... or (Osvaldová & Halada, 2019).
 - Three or More Authors: For works by three or more authors, use: Tušer et al. (2010) or (Tušer et al., 2010).
- Quotations: Always include page numbers for quotations, if available.
- List of Used Literature: List all references used, arranged alphabetically. Format the list with a hanging indent of 1.25 cm, aligning it to both margins. Use the format: **References MEDIG.**
